THE OTHER NEPAL PEACE PAGODAS AROUND THE WORLD

There are three known Nepal Peace Pagodas around the World. The Brisbane Nepal Peace Pagoda and the Munich Nepal Peace Pagoda were both commissioned in the 1980s, and are both exactly the same.

The Munich Nepal Peace Pagoda was created for the Kingdom of Nepal's representation at the 1983 International Garden Association Exposition there, and is located in the now parklands former Exposition site, Westpark, Munich. Internet searches for images from Westpark reveal several other international representatives from that Exposition there, and, that their Pagoda is used as a venue for traditional court Music.

The Osaka Japan Nepal Peace Pagoda was created for the Kingdom of Nepal's representation at the 1990 International Garden Exposition of Osaka, Japan. And appears to be similar to the Brisbane and Munich Pagodas.

The Brisbane Nepal Peace Pagoda is the only Nepal Peace Pagoda on the Australian continent, the only Nepal Peace Pagoda in the southern hemisphere, and is dedicated to World Peace for 1000 years.

The Friends of the Pagoda Association and Foundation Expo '88 are working to have the Pagoda's unique World Expo '88 and Nepalese heritage recognized on the Australian National Heritage List.
